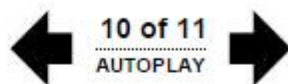
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## Where To Eat In Midtown Manhattan

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### Charlie Palmer at The Knick

The celebrated chef behind Sonoma's beloved Dry Creek Kitchen and New York's Aureole, Charlie Palmer adds another address to his growing collection of venues with this eponymous restaurant at the new Knickerbocker hotel. The space's mix of grey, beige, and brown decor makes for a slightly subdued ambience inside, but it's a calming contrast to the neon-saturated world of Times Square four stories below. Still, it's Palmer's fresh, refined takes on approachable fare—grilled romaine hearts with garlic breadcrumbs and pecorino, or a dry-aged burger topped with short rib and Irish cheddar—that keep us coming back.
